BBH Chapter 28 · Hophal Strong Verbs

Hophal prefix vowel: [ ] (strong/l-gutt); [ ] (l-yod/Biconsonantal). Hiphil prefix vowel: [ ] (perfect); [ ] (imperative); [ ] (participle). Biconsonantal: Hiphil perfect [ ] / Hophal perfect [ ] — one vowel distinguishes them.
